

Children’s worship bags and activities are available in the narthex for children worshipping with their families. There is also space in the parlor off the narthex for families who may need to step away at any point during the service.

On the Sundays nearest Memorial Day, Independence Day, and Veterans Day, our nation’s flag is placed in the narthex in gratitude for those whose national service helped ensure the freedoms we enjoy as Americans.
